





Just in from Jon Kaufman and Project H20pen Doors:

Since I haven't seen some of you, I wanted to give you a few breathless updates on what the project you've been so good to support is up to:

- We are shipping one **SunSpring to Nepal** 1. **NEXT WEEK!** Our Golf tournament registration fees and donations have provided us with the opportunity to take advantage of our Rapid-Response partner. We worked with them for the Philippines transport, if you recall. They are on the ground with a Harvard medical team, and say that the situation with water is critical, and electricity is out almost everywhere. They've identified a hospital, and the shipment will not cost us anything. Jack Barker will go out to Nepal once the SunSpring arrives and handle the installation. He'll be scoping it out for our return in August with two or more systems, when I will fly there. So, tell everyone you know what our club's project is doing, and to go to <u>www.H2Openoors.org</u>. I also post updates at www.Facebook.com/H2OpenDoors We want other clubs to know that an H2OpenDoors is the most efficient and fast way to make an impact for thousands of people at a time. We are here to help with guidance, oversight, and even the actual installation of the systems!
- 2. I'm going down to Mexico on Sunday for a site survey prior to our July expedition with the high school students. We have changed the installation site a bit...to an Otomi Indian village of 600 who live by the river we are going to be using. They will get free safe water, and will participate in the bottling operation (2-1/2 gallon reuseable bottles) for sales in San Miguel de Allende. 100% of the profits will go to support CRISMA, a center for disabled

children and part of the Fox family's foundation.

- 3. June 3 I leave for Sao Paulo and the Rotary International Convention. I decided not to ship a SunSpring for display in the House of Friendship...it was going to cost \$15,000! So I'll be pointing to photos a lot! Instead, that unit is the one going to Nepal. Seems like a better use at this time.
- 4. July 2-8 is our expedition to Mexico. Let me know if you would like to join us. We'll have about 24 people, and it will be amazing.
- 5. August...to Nepal for more installations.
- 6. November...the Rotary Project Fair in Ecuador. We will display a SS to Latin American Rotarians and NGO's, and hopefully, before that trip, I will have identified a project so I can leave it in the country!
- 7. January 2016... a return to Guatemala with District 5170 for a second SS installation.

Thanks for your interest and your support in H2OpenDoors over the past 3 years. As you can tell, we're just getting started! Please feel free to forward this to anyone on the planet who is looking for a soulful solution for thousands of people at a time, with 100% of contributions going to the project, rather than paid administrative staffs.




